Comments on the Learning Outcomes

Feedback on the learning outcomes which were evidenced well and those which require more focus based on the portfolios submitted in this series.

Most LO's well-evidenced, specially LOA, auditing in detail the DT's available and the use of each. LOE, with strong lesson plans using a range of digital technologies appropriately embedded.

LOJ requires more focus, with feedback forms that are focused on strengths, and are not that useful to find areas for further development.

Comments on the Assessment Criteria

Feedback on the Assessment Criteria which were addressed well and those which require more focus based on the portfolios submitted in this series.

AC2 is the strongest one in both candidates, with lesson plans that are carefully organised, using a structure that is linked to theories, or following a logic that facilitates learning to happen.

Ac4 needs more focus in some areas. Both PF's presented the reference list in order, one candidate did not follow the academic conventions when direct quoting. Abundant errors. Text should be reviewed before submitting.

Summary of areas for development
